



## Polar Night Cup

The Polar Night Cup is the biggest yearly event promoted by the Tromsø Table Tennis Club. It is a national ranking tournament which gathers players from all over Northern Norway, and sometimes from Northern Swedish clubs as well. The Polar Night Cup 2011 is the fourth tournament since we started it. It is our goal to make our tournament attractive to more clubs in the Barents Region, and we believe this year's visit from Arkhangelsk is the first big step in that direction.

Players cannot participate in two classes that start at the same time

#### **Match rules**

Matches are played best of 5 sets to 11 in all classes. All classes for players years 15 and under will be arranged with preliminary pools instead of cup. Cup or pool rules for all other classes will be decided at a later stage, but pools will be a priority.

#### **Prizes**

Prizes will follow the rules of the Norwegian Table Tennis Association. There will be money prizes in the Elite-classes, gifts for junior and senior classes, and medals/cups for the younger classes.

#### **Class limits**

No player can participate in more than 3 classes per day.

#### **Seeding**

Club and skill seeding will be done following the rules of the Norwegian Table Tennis Association

### **Entry fee**

Entry fee must be paid no later than November 11<sup>th</sup>. For international clubs that uses internet banking: IBAN number – NO86 4740 6386 752 / SWIFT-address SNOWNO22.

If international clubs don't use internet banking it is possible to pay the clubs entry fee Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> before classes start at 9pm. Payment must be made in NOK.

### **Important information**

Classes with 4 participants or less can be cancelled. In this case all affected clubs will be notified specifically, and it will be posted on Tromsø BTKs webpage [www.tromsobtk.no](http://www.tromsobtk.no). Girls can participate in boys and men's classes, and can by request be placed in corresponding boy's/men's classes in those cases where their initial class is cancelled.

### **Draw**

Each class is drawn approximately 20 minutes before start. All players and clubs must inform the tournament administration of forfeit players no later than 30 minutes before each class.
